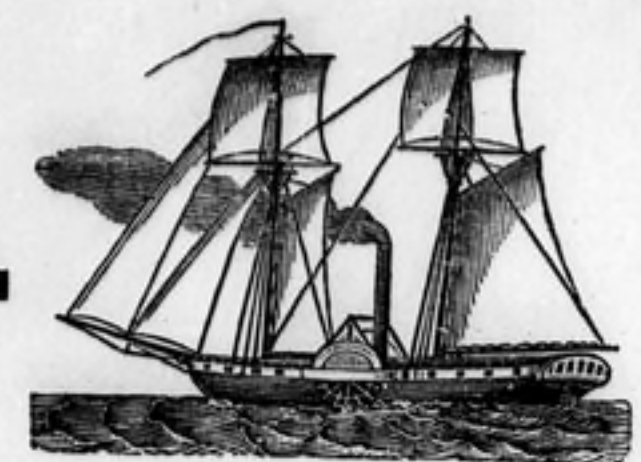

ENROLLMENT.



No. Sixty
IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the
 United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c.
 passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on
 the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other pur-
 poses,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Edward Nason of Buffalo NY*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together*
with Abner Cable and Robert Wauser of Fairport
Ohio and Jeremiah C. Oliver of Buffalo New York

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the
Fairport of Buffalo NY whereof *Jeremiah C. Oliver*
 is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn*
 is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Fairport*
Ohio in the year 18 *38* as appears by *his enrollment dated at Cleveland August*
24th 1838 now surrendered having changed owners & complied with the law of 7th July 1838
 And *the said Enrollment* having certified that
 the said *Steamboat* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her
 length is *One hundred and thirty five feet and nine inches*
 her breadth *Twenty three feet and four inches*
 her depth *Nine feet and no inches*
 and that she measures *Two hundred & fifty nine* tons *no* ninety-fifths;
 that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no galleries*
 and a *Swivel* head.
 And the said *Edward Nason* having
 agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been
 given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steamboat* has been duly
 Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

October in the year one thousand eight hun-
 dred and thirty- *Eight*
