



ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *J. H. Lathrop of Grand Island Civ County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Stephen White of the same place and William H. Sumner and Francis J. Oliver of Boston Massachusetts and Lewis H. Allen of Black Rock New York are*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Red Jacket* of *J. H. Lathrop* whereof *J. H. Lathrop* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sum* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Grand Island N.Y.* in the year 18*38* as appears by *his Enrolment dated at the Port 28 May 1838 now surrendered in compliance with the act of July 1838*

And *the said Enrolment* having certified that the said *Steamboat* or Vessel has *Two Masts* and *Two Decks* and that her length is *One Hundred and ten feet and no inches*, her breadth *Eighteen feet and no inches*, her depth *Eight feet* and that she measures *One hundred fifty eight tons twenty* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat*, has *no galleries*, and has a *Scull* head.

And the said *J. H. Lathrop* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
