



# ENROLLMENT.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Mathur Seville of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Atlantic of Buffalo* whereof *Mathur Seville* is at present Master; and, as he hath *Sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland Ohio* in the year 1833 as appears by *his Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo N.Y. 4th day of Nov 1838 now surrendered having changed owner*

And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Fifty five feet and seven 7/8 inches* her breadth *Eighteen feet and seven inches* her depth *Five feet and five and a half inches* and that she measures *Twenty Seven* tuns *Twenty Nine* ninety-fifths; that she is *a Schooner* has *no galleries* and *has a Stern* head.

And the said *Mathur Seville of Buffalo* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
