IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Walter Joy of Buffalo New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with S. B. Webster of Buffalo, Richard Winslow, N. C. Winslow, N. W. Chapman, Wm. Sargent, John Hallam, S. Kendall, N. W. McClure, R. W. McKel, C. L. Camp, J. G. McCurdy of Cleveland Ohio, N. Ely of Elyria Ohio, D. S. Baldwin of Charleston Ohio, J. S. Whiting of Detroit Michigan, John Allen & Co of Rochester and others of the association.*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Bank Hill of Buffalo* whereof *J. P. Nickerson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn *is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Charleston Ohio in the year 1837 as appears by her Enrolment dated at the Port of Cleveland October 1st 1838 and amended at this Port* And *the said Enrolment* having certified that the said *Steam Boat* or Vessel has *One Deck and Two Masts* and that her length is *One hundred and fifty four feet & four inches* her breadth *Twenty eight feet and four inches* her depth *Eleven feet and six inches* and that she measures *Five hundred & fifty seven* tuns *Twenty nine* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no* galleries and has a *Stegan* head. And the said *Walter Joy of Buffalo Erie County New York* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *Twenty second* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty-*three*
