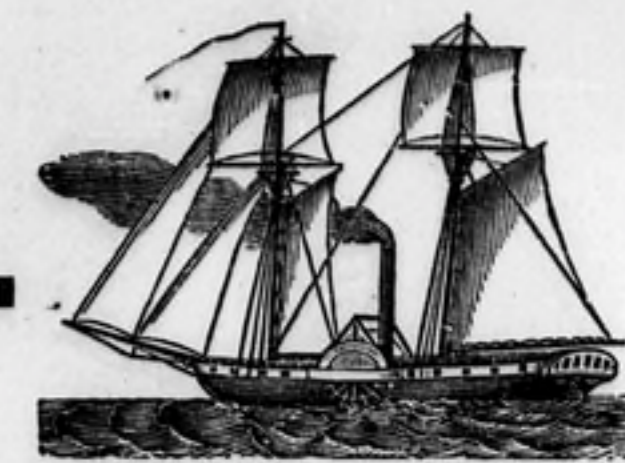




# ENROLLMENT.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *David Smith of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Mahlen Kirgman, and Joel P. Thayer, of Buffalo City N.Y. James T. Barte, Esq. Blackman, Ransom Blackman, Jacob P. Sush, and Lemuel P. Hutchinson of Newark N.Y. J. H. Hymans William Hymans and David Hymans of the City of Rochester N.Y. James C. Woodman and William H. Watson of Troy N.Y. and Alfred Knicker of New York*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the *Samuel of Buffalo* \_\_\_\_\_ whereof *John Sellers of Buffalo* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* \_\_\_\_\_

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Saline Ohio* \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 18 *27* as appears by her Enrollment dated at the *Port of Buffalo 12th July 1838* now unrecorded having changed owners

And the said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* \_\_\_\_\_ and that her length is *Sixty one feet and six inches* \_\_\_\_\_ her breadth *Sixteen feet and four and a half inches* \_\_\_\_\_ her depth *Six feet and two inches* \_\_\_\_\_ and that she measures *Fifty five* \_\_\_\_\_ tons *fifty seven* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* \_\_\_\_\_ has *no* galleries \_\_\_\_\_ and has a *Billit* \_\_\_\_\_ head.

And the said *David Smith of Buffalo New York* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
