



**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *John Pease of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Sheldon Thompson, of Sault Ste Marie, George C. L. Smith, of Sault Ste Marie, Robert McPherson, William A. Bird, Suleb Bliss and the assignees of Roscoe Carter and Henry A. Frost of Buffalo, New York, David Griffiths and Andrew M. Standard of Cleveland Ohio are*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Globe of Buffalo* whereof *Augustus Kasstey* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sumo*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Wab Thiers Ohio* in the year 1832 as appears by *his Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo July 11. 1837. now summited having changed owners*

And *an said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty three feet and eleven inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and four inches* her depth *Seven feet and one inch* and that she measures *One hundred fifty six* tuns *Ninty three* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and *has a billett* head.

And the said *John Pease of Buffalo N.Y.* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *twenty ninth* day of *April* in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty. *Wm A. S. Stebbins* Deputy Collector
