IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *William W Wards of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Moses Fuller of Seven Creeks New York*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Barcelona of Irving* whereof *John Vaie* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Punville Upper Canada* in the year 1836 as appears by her Enrolment dated at this Port *23rd April 1838.* Now *surrendered having been attached from a Steam Boat to a Schooner* And the said *William W Wards* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Ninety five feet and nine inches* her breadth *Seventeen feet and four inches* her depth *Five feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Eighty nine* tuns *Seventy four* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and a *Scroll* head. And the said *William W Wards* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
