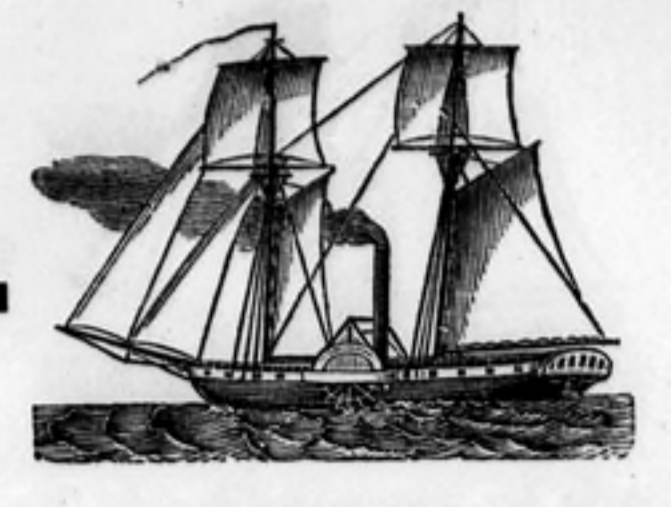

ENROLLMENT.



No. 17 *Seventeen*

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *James C. Evans of Buffalo N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Samuel F. Selster of Buffalo N. Y. John Casare of Barcellona, William C. Davison, and John P. Davison of Buffalo*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Reindeer* whereof *William C. Davison* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Concauch Ohio* in the year *1835* as appears by the *former* Enrollment granted at *this Port*, and having been lost as appears by the oath of *Stephen S. Selden* Master. And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty Six* feet her breadth *Eighteen* feet her depth *Six feet and two inches* and that she measures *Sixty Six* tons *Forty Seven* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* galleries and a *Small* head. And the said *James C. Evans* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
