



ENROLLMENT.

No. 11 *Cyphers*

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Jumiah C. Olivar of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Charles Price of the same place*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Platina of Buffalo* whereof *Jumiah C. Olivar*

is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1834 as appears by *his Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo June 13. 1838 now surrendered having changed owner*

And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck and Two masts* and that her length is *Seventy Feet*

her breadth *Seventy Five Feet and eight inches*

her depth *Seven Feet and three inches*

and that she measures *at sixty* tuns *about three* ninety-fifths;

that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries*

and has *no Stern* head.

And the said *Jumiah C. Olivar* having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been

given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly

Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
