**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Simeon Fox of Buffalo, Erie County, New York.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *Richard Banta & Co. Ralph Carter, Helton & Evans, Eli R. Wilkeson, Cameron & Mc Kay, Cameron Adams & Co. Augustus C. Stevens, Thomas Smith, Clark Williamson & Co. Wm Edwards & Co. Job Hollywood Harry C. Morris, Nelson Willard of the same place, Oliver Lee, Charles Swift, Wm. Farham, of Buffalo Creek, John Earn of Berechna. George French of Seneca Co. N. Y.*

Citizens of the United States, <sup>are</sup> sole owners of the Steamboat or Vessel called the *Chautauque of Buffalo* whereof *Simeon Fox* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo, N. Y.* in the year 1839 as appears by a certificate of the Master *Richard Banta*, dated at the Port of *Buffalo, June 1839*

And *Jack W. Banta, master-builder* having certified that the said Steamboat or Vessel has *two decks* and *one mast* and that her length is *one hundred & twenty three feet eight inches* her breadth *eighteen feet two inches* her depth *seven feet six inches* and that she measures *one hundred & fifty one* — tuns *sixty nine* — ninety-fifths; that she is a *steamboat* has *no gallery* and has a *scull* head.

And the said *Simeon Fox* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo Creek*.
