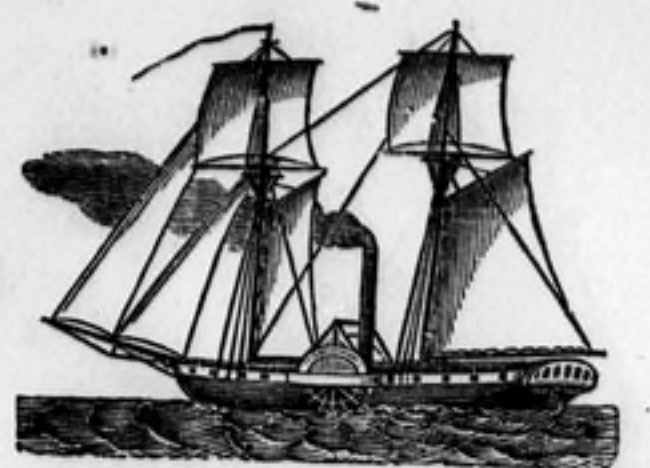


ENROLLMENT.



One
IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Francis P. Billings of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together* with *Charles A. Comstock of the same place & James M. Knile of Monroe Michigan* are

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Marshall* whereof *Francis P. Billings* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *River* *St Clair* in the year 1830 as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port of Detroit 15th April 1833. *summers having changed owner*
And *The said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *Sixty five feet* her breadth *Nineteen feet* her depth *Six feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Seventy three* tons *twenty five* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and *no* head.
And the said *Francis P. Billings* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
