**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *William N. McCoy Attorney for Richard H. Foster and Samuel Taft of Lyons Wayne County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Joseph*  
*an*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Edward Bancroft* whereof *A. D. Perkins* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sum* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *New York* in the year 18 *34* as appears by *his* Enrollment dated at *this* *Port* the *15<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* 18 *39*, now *summed* having changed owner. And *the* said Enrollment *you* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One* Deck and *Two* Masts — and that her length is *Seventy nine* feet and *nine* inches her breadth *Twenty* feet and *two* inches her depth *Eight* feet and *no* inches and that she measures *One hundred* of *fourteen* tuns *ten* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* galleries and *no* *Figure* head. And the said *Wm N McCoy* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
