

# ENROLLMENT.

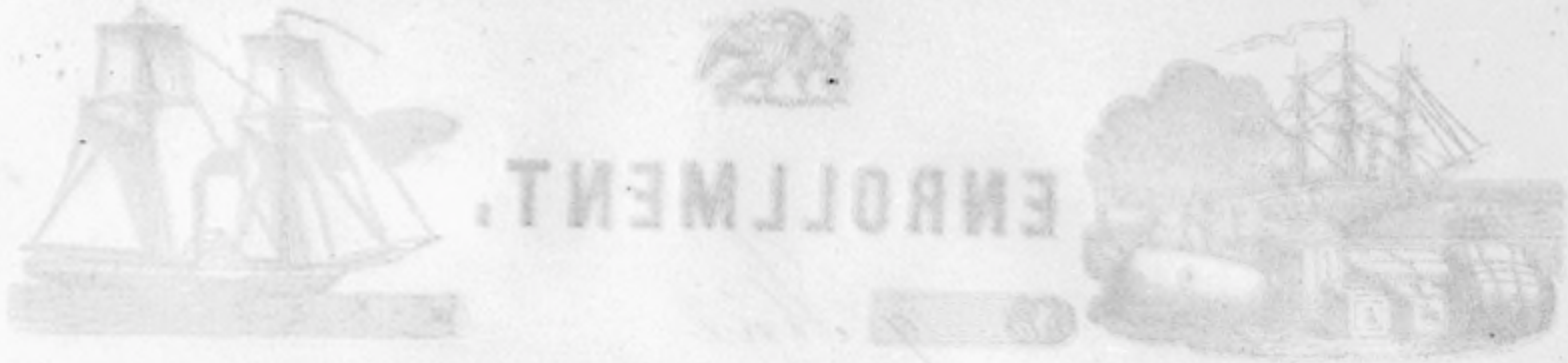
**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Robert B Chase of Cleveland Ohio*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with James S Conner of Belvidere Michigan Reuben W Foster and Abel Taft of Lyons NY*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Mellen* whereof *Robert B Chase* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Madison Ohio* in the year 1834 as appears by her *Enrollment* dated at *Cleveland Ohio 16th April 1838*. *Summers* having changed owner, And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *fifty eight feet and eight inches* her breadth *fifteen feet and two inches* her depth *six feet and three fourths inches* and that she measures *fifty four* tuns *seventy eight* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and a *figure* head. And the said *Robert B Chase* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
