



ENROLLMENT.



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *A. R. Cobb of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Bismaley Sweet of Ohio City Ohio*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *A. C. Baldwin* whereof *Bismaley Sweet* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Cleveland Ohio* in the year 1836 as appears by *Her Enrolment dated at Cleveland June 20th 1838. Summendum, having changed owners* And *The said Enrolment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty One feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and five inches* her depth *Eight feet and eight and a half inches* and that she measures *One hundred forty four tons thirty six ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and a *Scow* head. And the said *A. R. Cobb* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
