



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Warren C. Whaley of Saginaw W. U.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Sloop Schooner* or Vessel called the *Cool Leaches of Spring* whereof *Sam Stone* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Dun Kirk New York* in the year 18³⁵ as appears by *The Certificate of new Enrollment which Enrollment has been lost & an affidavit to that effect taken* And *The said Certificate of Enrollment* having certified that the said *Sloop Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty two feet* her breadth *Fourteen feet* her depth *Three feet and six inches* and that she measures *Twenty seven* tuns *Sixty* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Sloop Schooner* has *no galleries* and *no* head. And the said *Warren C. Whaley* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sloop Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
