



ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. Samuel W. Hawes, of Buffalo, N. Y. attorney for William S. Hawes of New Bedford, Mass -

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that the said William S. Hawes, together with Charles S. Keeler of Lucas County, Ohio, Augustus Douglas, Jennings V. Leheny, Frays V. Barnard of Ohio,

Citizens of the United States, ^{are} sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Major Oliver whereof William Kyle is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built ~~at~~ the Maumee River, Ohio, in the year 18 37 as appears by her former enrollment, dated at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the District of Buffalo, the tenth day of May 1839 and numbered sixteen, which enrollment is now surrendered, by reason of a change of names. And the said enrollment

having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has one deck and two masts and that her length is eighty one feet.

her breadth twenty three feet six inches

her depth nine feet six inches

and that she measures one hundred fifty eight tons nine ninety-fifths;

that she is a Schooner has no galleries

and a scroll head.

And the said Samuel W. Hawes, for the said William S. Hawes having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
