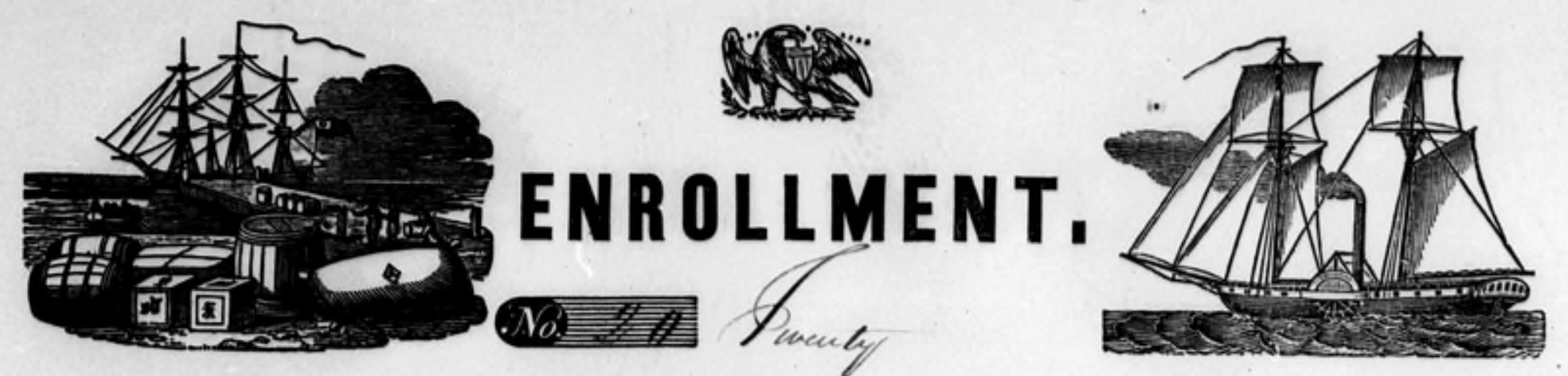

Haver* of *New Bedford, Mass* by his Attorney *Samuel W. Haver*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with *J. G. Nickerson* of *Ohio* City *Ohio* & *William & Daniel Williams* of *Mass*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Ottawa* whereof *Justin Bailey* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Maumee River Ohio* in the year 1837 as appears by *Her Enrolment* dated at *the Port of Maumee the 6<sup>th</sup> of April 1840* *subscribed having changed names* And *the said Enrolment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts*—and that her length is *Eighty three feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and four inches* her depth *Nine feet and no inches* and that she measures *One hundred fifty three tuns Sixty* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no* galleries and a *Screw* head. And the said *William T. Haver* by his Attorney having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo Creek*.
