



# ENROLLMENT.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *And an Act for the better security of the lives of Passengers &c. Passed the 4th day July 1838 Charles W Reed of Erie Pennsylvania*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with* Eric Allen John Patterson and Lucius Stross of the City of Buffalo, N.Y., W.H. Goodsell, George Wolcott and J.W. Pierce of Vermillion Ohio, W.S. Mill and L.S. Lattin of Maumee Ohio, Benedict W. Hitchcock of Cleveland Ohio, O.A. Leonard of Birmingham Ohio, and Jackson H. Graham of Erie Pennsylvania being

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Missouri of Buffalo* whereof *Thomas Wilkins* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Vermillion Ohio* in the year 1840 as appears by the Oath of *W.S. Goodsell* Master Resident at *Augustus 2. Stubbins* being appointed by the Collector at *Maumee* said Vessel. And the said *Goodsell* and *Stubbins* having certified that the said *Steam Boat* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *One Hundred and Eighty feet* her breadth *Twenty eight feet and eight inches* her depth *Twelve feet and five and a half inches* and that she measures *Six Hundred & twelve* tons *One* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no* galleries and head.

And the said *Charles W Reed* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
