IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Said Cook of Erasm Co. County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with James V. Gato of the same place*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Victory of Swin* whereof *Said Cook* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sum* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo New York* in the year 1834 as appears by *the Certificate of the former Enrollment, dated at Buffalo 26th April 1834 the same being lost* And *Joac H. Munk* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty five feet* her breadth *Sixteen feet and four inches* her depth *Six feet* and that she measures *Seventy seven* tuns *fifty three* ninety-fifths; that she *has been altered* is a Schooner has *no galleries* and *no* head.

And the said *Said Cook* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
