IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Jacob Linn of Lonskirk - N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he and *Henry M. Kinnear, of the City of Buffalo, N. Y.* are

Citizens of the United States, sole owner(s) of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *W. B. Buckner* whereof *the said Jacob Linn* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Ironing in the State of New York in the year 1837* as appears by her Enrollment dated at the Port the *thirtieth day of June 1840.* *Now surrendered by reason of a change of owner* And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Schooner or Vessel* has *one deck* and *two masts* and that her length is *Seventy four feet and ten inches* her breadth *twenty one feet and one and one fourth inches* her depth *Seven feet and nine inches* and that she measures *one hundred & six tons and ninety three ninety-fifths;* that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and head.

And the said *Jacob Linn* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
