**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831.

And an act for the better security of the lives of Passengers &c. Passed the 7th day of July 1838. —

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with James Magget of Black Rock N.Y. being

Citizens of the United States/sole owners of the Steam Ferry Boat or Vessel called the *Matulos* whereof James Walker is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock New York* in the year 1840 as appears by *Jacob W. Banta's* certificate of admeasurement dated at this Port the 13th day of October 1840 And the said *Jacob W. Banta* having certified that the said Steam Boat or Vessel has *Two* decks — and *no* masts — and that her length is *Ninety one* feet and *six* and a half inches — her breadth *Eighteen* feet and *four* inches — her depth *Six* feet and *four* inches — and that she measures *Ninety eight* — tuns *forty two* — ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Ferry Boat* — has *no* gallies — and *no* figure head. And the said *John Fellows* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
