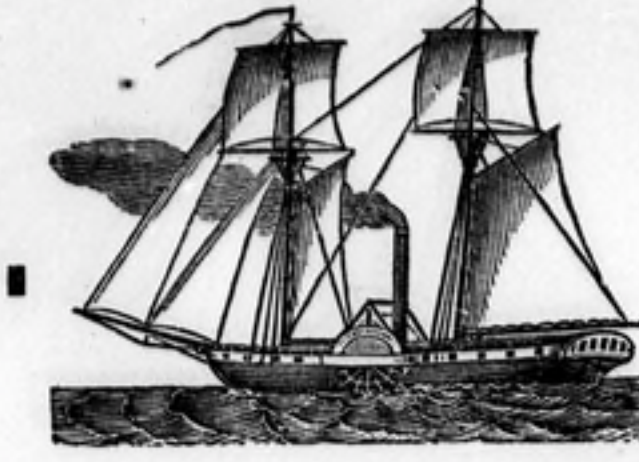

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Isaac Smith* of Buffalo N.Y. Attorney for *Joseph Saray* of Syracuse N.Y.

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having ~~affirmed~~ that the said *Joseph Saray* of Syracuse is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Texas of Buffalo* whereof *E. C. Banaude* is at present Master; and, as he hath affirmed is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black Rock Ohio* in the year 1836 as appears by *Her Enrolment* dated at this Port the 2^d day of May 1840 now surrendered having changed owners And *The said Enrolment* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy eight feet and three inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet two and a half inches* her depth *Eight feet and seven inches* and that she measures *One hundred & thirty four* tuns *Sixty* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has *no* galleries and a *Scull* head. And the said *Isaac Smith* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *Twenty fourth* day of *October* in the year one thousand eight hundred and ~~thirty~~ *forty* *Isaac Smith* Dep. Com.
