



# ENROLLMENT.

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *And an act for the better security of the lives of Passengers & Passes the 7th day of July 1842. Simon Dix of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Richard Ranta & Co, Gelatin & Co, Eli W. Wilkes, Truman & May, Cannon Adams & Co, Augustus C. Brown, Howard Smith, Clark Williamson & Co, William Edwards, & Co John Holley, Henry C. Morris & Nelson Willard, of the same place, Charles Chailes, Smith, W. W. Hamham, of Sibley, and John Eason of Barcelona and George French of Denmark, N. Y. being* Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Chaunque of Buffalo* whereof *Simon Dix* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo New York* in the year 1839 as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at Buffalo N. Y. 15th June 1839 now surrendered having changed owners* And the said Enrollment having certified that the said *Steamboat* or Vessel has *Two Decks*, and *One Mast* and that her length is *One Hundred twenty three feet eight inches* her breadth *Eighteen feet and two inches* her depth *Seven feet and six inches* and that she measures *One hundred Sixty One tons Sixty Nine* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no galleries* and has a *Scull* head. And the said *Simon Dix* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
