**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Samuel W. Hawes of Buffalo NY being Attorney for William P. Hawes of New Bedford Massachusetts*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that the said *William P. Hawes of New Bedford together with Joy K Webster of Buffalo NY and J. S. Mickerson of Cleveland Ohio* all

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Ship* \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the *Superior of Buffalo* \_\_\_\_\_ whereof *J. S. Mickerson* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* \_\_\_\_\_ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Warren Michigan* in the year 1834 as appears by *Her Enrolment dated at this Port the 27th of May 1840. Now summoned having changed course* And *the said Enrolment* \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said *Ship* or Vessel has *One Deck and Three Masts* and that her length is *One Hundred and twenty eight feet* her breadth *Twenty nine feet and no inches* her depth *Ten feet and eight inches* and that she measures *Three hundred fifty eight tons Eighty Eight* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Ship* \_\_\_\_\_ has *no galleries* \_\_\_\_\_ and *has a figure* \_\_\_\_\_ head. And the said *Samuel W. Hawes* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Ship* \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
