



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. And an act for the better security of the lives of Passengers & Crews the 7th day of July 1835.

Alexander McKay of Buffalo NY of the firm of Carnum & McKay having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Bridwell Banta Esq. Eli W. Wilkeson, Carnum & McKay Carnum Adams Esq. Augustus Stevens, Thomas Smith, Clark Williamson Esq. William Edwards, Esq. J. H. Colquhoun, Henry C. Morris Nelson Wilbur and David Smith, all of the same place, Clara Lee, Chat Swift, W. W. Gramham of Sibley Creek W. H. Johnson of Barcelona and George Branch of Denmark NY being Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the *Chatanque of Buffalo* whereof *E. S. Masten* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo* *McKay* in the year 1839 as appears by *New Enrollment* dated at this Port the 13th day of March 1841. Now summoned having changed owner, And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Steam Boat* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *One Hundred Twenty three feet and eight inches* her breadth *Eighteen feet and two inches* her depth *Seven feet and six inches* and that she measures *One Hundred Sixty one tons Sixty nine* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *One* gallon and *has a* *Scroll* head.

And the said *Alexander McKay* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steam Boat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
