



# ENROLLMENT.

*Seventeenth*

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Samuel W. Howe* of Buffalo N.Y. being Attorney for *William J. Howe*, of New Bedford Massachusetts

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he the said *William J. Howe* of New Bedford and *J. P. Wickson* of this City (his being

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Maawa of Buffalo* whereof *J. P. Wickson* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Maunee River Ohio* in the year 1837 as appears by *New Enrollment dated at this Port the 2<sup>d</sup> June 1840.* Now surrendered having changed owners And *The said Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Iron Mast* and that her length is *Eighty three feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and four inches* her depth *Nine feet and six inches* and that she measures *One hundred fifty three tuns Sixty* ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries and a Stern head. And the said *Samuel W. Howe* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
