 And *The said Enrollment* _____ having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* — and that her length is *Sixty Eight feet* _____ her breadth *Twenty One feet and five inches* _____ her depth *Seven feet and seven inches* _____ and that she measures *Ninety three* _____ tuns *Nineteen* — ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* _____ has *No* galleries _____ and _____ head.
 And the said *Jacob Travers* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo Creek*.
