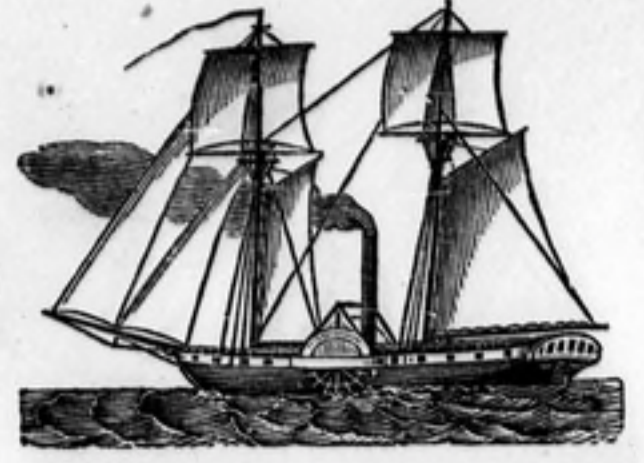

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Oliver Ruger of Buffalo Creek N. Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Sarah Ruger* whereof *Charles Barber* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Silow Creek New York* in the year 1841 as appears by a Certificate of *Chas Barber* of *Manum N. Y.* Master Builder dated the 22^d day of *June* 1841.

And the said Certificate having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *Eighty four feet and two inches*

her breadth *Twenty two feet and nine inches*

her depth *Eight feet and five inches*

and that she measures *One Hundred forty one* tons *Eighty six* ninety-fifths;

that she is a Schooner has *no Gallies* and a *Deck* head.

And the said *Oliver Ruger* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
