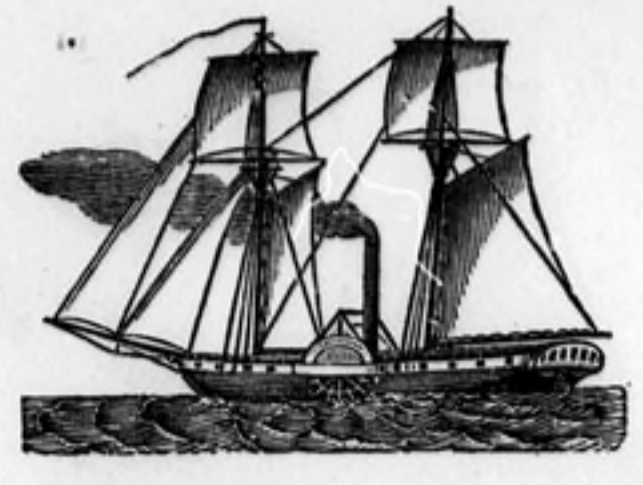




# ENROLLMENT.



No. 111 *Platy four*

**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Amos R. Cobb of Buffalo New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Chauncy Tucker of Fredonia New York being*

Port of Chicago  
Surrendered this 10th day  
of June 1847 by reason of a change of  
Whitsicht, and owned  
by W. B. Snowbroke  
Levied.*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Brig* or Vessel called the *Samuel B. Ruggles* whereof *Walter Black* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Dunkirk New York* in the year 18 *37* as appears by *Her Enrollment stated at this Port 15th July 1840. Her Surrendered, having changed owners* And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Brig* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *One Mast* and that her length is *Ninety feet and two inches* her breadth *Twenty four feet and two inches* her depth *Nine feet and five inches* and that she measures *One hundred eighty three tons thirty four ninety-fifths;* that she is a *Brig* has *no galleries* and *has a Quarter* head. And the said *Amos R. Cobb* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.

Given under my Hand and Seal of Office, at the Port of Buffalo Creek, in the said District, this *Twentieth* day of *October* in the year one thousand eight hundred and *thirty*. *Forty One*
