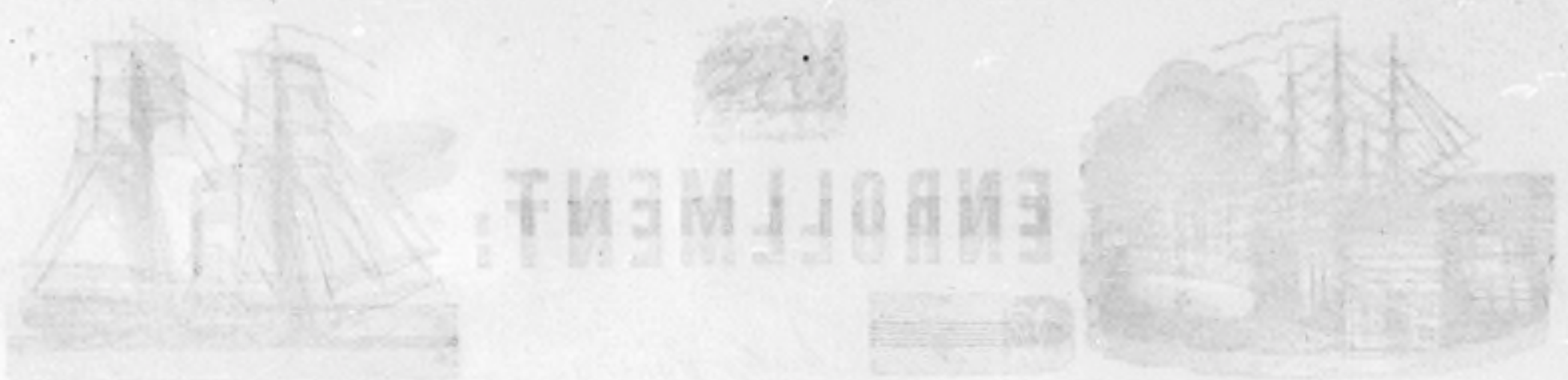


IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *George D. Prince of Buffalo Erie County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Edwin Jenny* whereof *George D. Prince* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn *George D. Prince* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Mount Clemens Michigan* in the year 18*37* as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at this Port 29th April 1841 N^o 3.* having charged owners *George D. Prince* And *George D. Prince* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy feet and no inches* her breadth *Twenty One feet and eleven inches* her depth *Six feet and ten inches* and that she measures *Eighty two* tuns *Thirty seven ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and a *Scroll* head. And the said *George D. Prince* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of *Buffalo Creek*.
