IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. Citizens of the United States/sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Nicholas Bidelle whereof Abraham Roman is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Piquette Lake Pennsylvania in the year 1837 as appears by New Enrolment dated at this Port the 28th April 1844. No. 14 now summers having changed owners And the said Enrolment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Seventy two feet and nine inches her breadth Twenty feet and nine inches her depth Eight feet and that she measures One Hundred five tuns forty six ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries and has a scroll head. And the said Henry M. Knime having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
