



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *And, an Act for the better security of the lives of Passengers & Passes, this 7th July 1838.*
Charles L. Gayer of Buffalo Erie County New York
 having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Steam Boat* or Vessel called the *Red Jacket of Buffalo* whereof *Charles L. Gayer* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn *under oath* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Grand Island New York* in the year 1838 as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at this Port October 15th 1838. Now surrendered having been sold by the U.S. Marshal*
 And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Steamboat* or Vessel has *Two Decks* and *no Mast* and that her length is *One Hundred and ten feet* her breadth *Sixteen feet* her depth *Eight* and that she measures *One Hundred forty eight* stuns *twenty* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Steam Boat* has *no gallies* and a *small* head.
 And the said *Charles L. Gayer* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Steamboat* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
