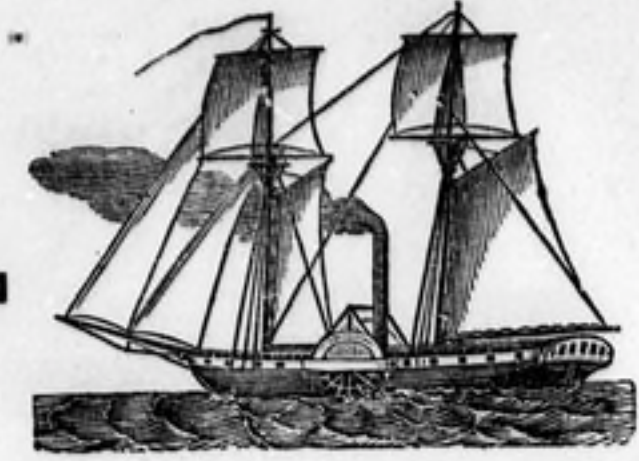




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Worace Snow of Buffalo Erie County N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Navigators of Buffalo* whereof *Worace Snow* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Erie Pennsylvania* in the year 1834 as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at this Port the 28th day of June 1838 now amended having changed owners* And the said *Enrollment* _____ having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty nine feet* her breadth *Eighteen feet and ten inches* her depth *Seven feet and four inches* and that she measures *Eighty two* _____ tuns *Eighty six* _____ ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* _____ has *no galleries* _____ and a *stern* _____ head. And the said *Worace Snow* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
