



**IN CONFORMITY** to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Rufus C. Palmer of Buffalo Erie County NY*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with George W. Holt and Giles Roberts of the same place and Robert Hunter of Albany Newberry & Cole of Chicago and James H. Forsythe of Maumee Ohio being*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Michigan* whereof *Russell S. Leary* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn*

is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Port Miami in 1832* *substituted* in the year 1842 as appears by *the Enrollment dated at this Port the 14th May 1841 No 31. now surrendered having been rebuilt and measured*

And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy five feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty two feet and eleven inches* her depth *Eight feet and two inches* and that she measures *One Hundred twenty one tons fifty two ninety-fifths;* that she is a *Schooner* has *no gallies*

and a *Scow* head. And the said *Rufus C. Palmer* having

agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
