IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Walter Joy of Buffalo Cui County New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together with George P. Webster of the same place being*

Citizens of the United States, sole owner of the *Brig* or Vessel called the *Alert of Buffalo* whereof *William W. Sewell* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sum* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Black River Ohio* in the year 1842 as appears by the certificate of *A. J. Jones* Master builder dated at this Port the 29th day of April 1842. And *Augustus D. O'Brien* Surveyor having certified that the said *Brig* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy Seven feet and six inches* her breadth *Twenty two feet and eleven inches* her depth *Eight feet and one inch* and that she measures *One hundred twenty five tons Thirty four ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Brig* has *no galleries* and *Chas. Scoble* head. And the said *Walter Joy* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
