



ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. Benjamin F. Owen of Silver Creek New York

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he Together with Oliver Lee of the same place being

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Savannah of Silver Creek whereof Benjamin F. Owen is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Silver Creek NY in 1836, rebuilt in the year 1842 as appears by New Enrollment dated at this Port 11th June 1841 No 25, and the Certificate of Charles Barber dated 5th May 1842 And The said Charles Barber having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Eighty four feet and nine inches her breadth Twenty two feet her depth Seven feet and two inches and that she measures One hundred eighteen tuns Seventy eight ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no galleries and has a screw head. And the said Benjamin F. Owen having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
