having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *together with Rufus C. Salun. Giles H. Coats. George M. Keith of the same place and Robert Hunter of Albany N.Y. being*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Prig* or Vessel called the *Robert Hunter* whereof *William Dickson* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sum* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Buffalo New York* in the year *1841* as appears by *the Enrollment dated at this Port the 2nd day of April 1841. No. 11. now surrendered having changed course* And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Prig* or Vessel has *one Deck* and *two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty seven feet and three inches* her breadth *Twenty three feet and four inches* her depth *Five feet* and that she measures *One hundred sixty one* tons *Eighty seven ninety-fifths*; that she is *Prig* has *no galleries* and head. And the said *William Dickson* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Prig* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
