Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the Albany of Buffalo whereof Jacob Smeen is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Milan Ohio in the year 1841 as appears by New Enrollment dated at the Port of Portland May 25<sup>th</sup> 1841 N.Y. now surrendered having changed owners And The said Enrollment having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is Eighty two feet and six inches her breadth Twenty three feet and six inches her depth Eight feet and six inches and that she measures One hundred forty four tons three ninety-fifths; that she is a Schooner has no gallery and has a Screw head. And the said Jacob Smeen having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
