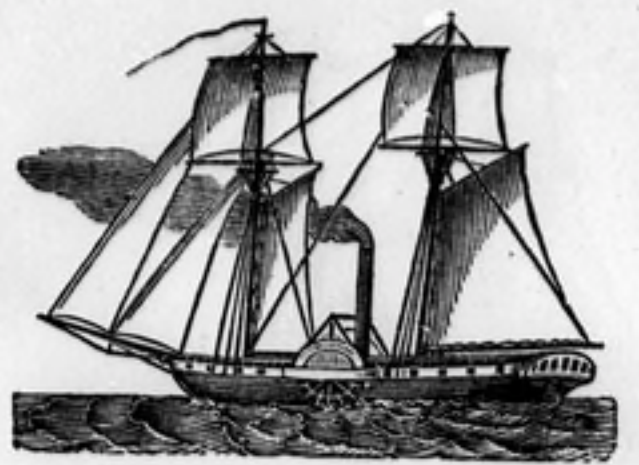


ENROLLMENT.



IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the

United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *Jeremiah Ellsworth of New York*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *being a*

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the *Sea Schooner* or Vessel called the *Etna* whereof *Jeremiah Ellsworth* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Schenectady New York* in the year 1841 as appears by *New Enrollment dated at this Port 22^d July 1841 No 31* and *summoned having charged owners* And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Sea Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Sixty eight feet and eleven inches* her breadth *Eighteen feet and eleven inches* her depth *Six feet and four inches* and that she measures *Sixty three* tuns *twenty five* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Sea Schooner* has *no galleries* and *no* head. And the said *Jeremiah Ellsworth* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Sea Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
