Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Brig* \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the *Warungah* \_\_\_\_\_ whereof *Wm Rolician* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *White Plains New York* in the year 1838 as appears by *the Enrollment dated at this Port May 13<sup>th</sup> 1840 No 19. now surrendered having been altered from a Schooner to Brig* And *The said Enrollment* \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that the said *Brig* \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Eighty two feet and five inches* her breadth *Twenty feet and two inches* her depth *Eight feet and two inches* and that she measures *One Hundred & twenty nine tons seventy six ninety-fifths*; that she is a *Brig* \_\_\_\_\_ has *no* gallons \_\_\_\_\_ and a *Beak* \_\_\_\_\_ head. And the said *Amos R Cobb* \_\_\_\_\_ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Brig* \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
