



ENROLLMENT.

No. 111 *Stoby Six*
IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *William Wate of Buffalo N.Y.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together with Samuel A. Proost of the same place, E. H. Weston of New York David Griffith and Andrew W. Standart of Cleveland of Ohio being*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *Constitution of Buffalo* whereof *William Wate* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1826 as appears by *Her Enrollment dated at this Port 18th May 1838 N^o 118. Now surrendered having changed Owners* And *The said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy One feet* her breadth *Twenty feet and six inches* her depth *Seven feet and six inches* and that she measures *Thirty One* tuns *Seventy Seven* ninety-fifths; that she is *a Schooner* has *no galleries* and *a screw* head. And the said *William Wate* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
