



ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "*An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels,*" &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "*An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes,*" passed the 2d March, 1831. *Warren C. Whaley of Warren*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

Citizen of the United States, sole owner of the Schooner or Vessel called the *Leon Lawrence* whereof *Warren C. Whaley* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Union Ohio* in the year 1842 as appears by *His Enrollment dated at the Port of Portland July 10, 1841. No. now remembered having changed names* And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said Schooner or Vessel has *One Deck and Two Masts* and that her length is *Fifty eight feet and eight inches 58-8* her breadth *Seven feet 17-0* her depth *five feet and six inches 5-6* and that she measures *Fifty seven* tons *Sixty nine* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has a *Swallow* and no head. And the said *Warren C. Whaley* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
