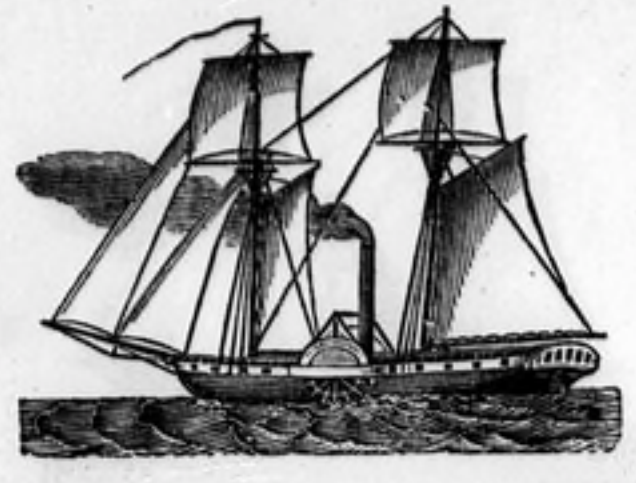




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY to an Act of the Congress of the United States of America, entitled "An Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th of February, 1793; and "An Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831. *William Hodge Jr of Buffalo Erie County New York.*

having taken or subscribed the Oath required by said Acts, and having sworn that he *Together with Edmund W. Duvose of the same place being*

Citizens of the United States, sole owners of the *Schooner* or Vessel called the *North Carolina of Buffalo* whereof *Edmund W. Duvose* is at present Master; and, as he hath *sworn* is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sheffield Ohio* in the year 1835 as appears by *the Enrollment dated at this Port the 27th June 1838 N. 36. Sumnerland having changed owners & being altered from a Brig to a Schooner* And *the said Enrollment* having certified that the said *Schooner* or Vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts* and that her length is *Seventy three feet and three inches* her breadth *Twenty five feet and nine inches* her depth *Seven feet and Two inches* and that she measures *Ninty five* tuns *fifteen* ninety-fifths; that she is a *Schooner* has *no galleries* and a *Figure* head. And the said *William Hodge Jr* having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said *Schooner* has been duly Enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
