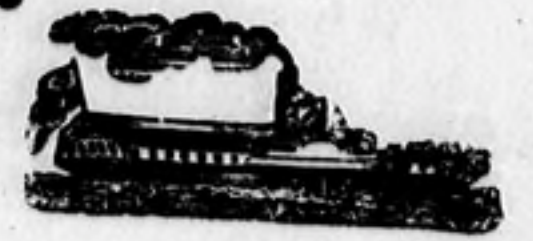

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

William Wate of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he *Recognizes* with *E. A. Norton of New York, David Griffiths and Archibald W. Stewart of Cincinnati Ohio being*

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner _____ or Vessel called the *Constitution of Buffalo* whereof *William Wate* is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn, _____ is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at *Sandusky Ohio* in the year 1826 as appears by *Mar. Enrollment dated at this Port the 29th September 1842* &c. *the name of the vessel having changed since*

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has *One Deck* and *Two Masts*; and that her length is *Seventy One feet* her breadth *Twenty feet and Six inches* her depth *Seven feet and Six inches* and that she measures *Ninety One* tons *Seventy Seven* ninety-fifths: that she is a Schooner _____ has _____ and a *Single* _____ head.

And the said *William Wate* _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
