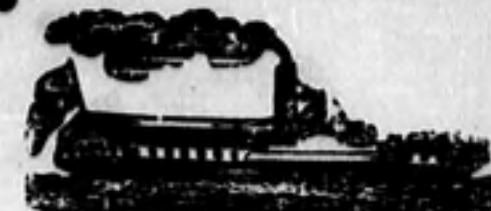

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William C. Davison of Black Rock N.Y. having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with John P. Davison, James C. Evans and Samuel F. Sheldon of Buffalo New York

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner or Vessel called the

Reindeer whereof C. Davison is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at a certain place in the year 1835 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo 18th September 1840, now surrendered having been rebuilt as appears by the Certificate of W. C. Davison dated May 9th 1842. And the said W. C. Davison having certified that the said Schooner or vessel has two Masts and one Deck and that her length is Sixty feet and Six inches her breadth Eighteen feet and no inches her depth Seven feet and five inches and that she measures Sixty nine tons Eighty ninety-fifths that she is a Schooner has no galleries and Scull head.

And the said William C. Davison having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
