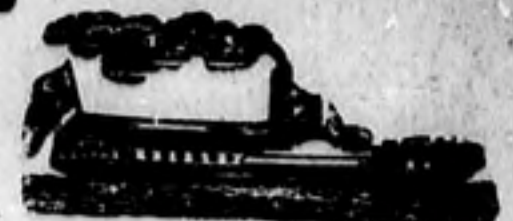

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Peter S. Parsons of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with Orasmus D. Robinson and Jeremiah A. Rabody of the same place, and Henry B. Clark of Chicago Illinois

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Steam Boat or Vessel called the James Allen of Buffalo wherof A. Howard is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at _____ in the year 18____ as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo September 17th 1840 ²³ now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that the said Steam Boat or vessel has _____ and _____ and that her length is One hundred and thirty feet her breadth Twenty One feet her depth Eight feet and seven inches and that she measures Two hundred & thirteen tons _____ ninety-fifths: that she is a Steam Boat _____ has _____ and _____ head.

And the said Peter S. Parsons _____ having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Steam Boat _____ has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
