

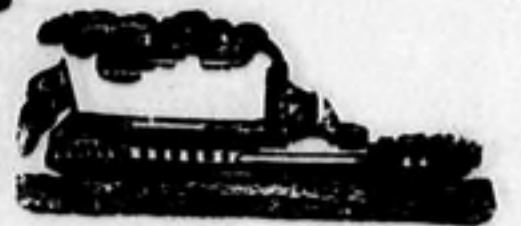

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

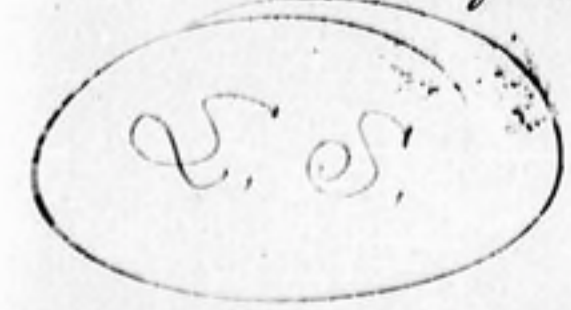
Charles Howland of Buffalo N.Y. Managing Owner having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he together with William D. Taber of the same place being

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Brig Rosa or Vessel called the Rosa whereof William D. Taber

is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn is a Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River Ohio in the year 1841 as appears by Her Enrollment dated at the Port of Buffalo the 29<sup>th</sup> April 1842 No 21 now surrendered having changed owners

And The said Enrollment having certified that the said Brig or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her length is seventy nine feet seven and a half inches her breadth Twenty three feet eight and a half inches her depth Ten feet two and a half inches and that she measures One hundred seventy seven tons Sixty nine ninety-fifths that she is a Brig has No Gallies and No figure head.

And the said Charles Howland having agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conformity with the terms of the said acts, the said Brig has been duly enrolled at the Port of Buffalo Creek.
