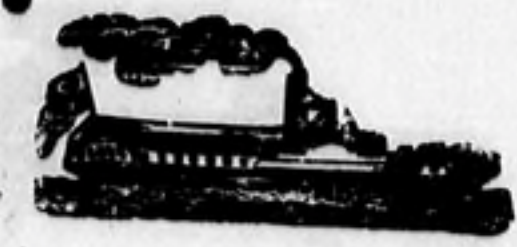

IN CONFORMITY TO
An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing
Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and
Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for
other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives
of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Robert Hollister of Buffalo N.Y.
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he is a

CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owner of the steam Propeller or Vessel called the
Arctus whereof Geo. W. Lloyd
is at present Master; and, as he hath sworn
Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Buffalo
New York in the year 1845 as appears by The certificate of
J. W. Panta Shipwright

And the said certificate having certified that
the said steam Propeller or vessel has Two Decks and Two Masts and that her
length is One Hundred Thirty six feet, and Three inches
her breadth Twenty four feet and Ten inches
her depth Eight feet and one inch
and that she measures Two Hundred Fifty six tons Thirty nine ninety-fifths
that she is a steam Propeller has No galley
and No figure head.

And the said Robert Hollister having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in confor-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said steam Propeller has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
