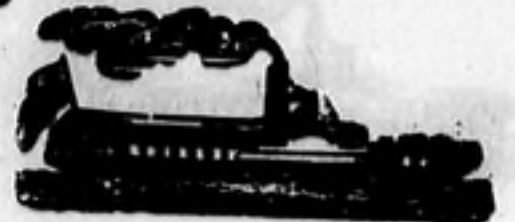




ENROLLMENT.

IN CONFORMITY TO
An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," &c. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Black River
in the year 1836 as appears by the Enrollment dated
at the Port of Buffalo the 30 day of March 1842 No 6
now surrendered having changed owners

And the said Enrollment _____ having certified that
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck and Two Masts and that her
length is Twenty Eight feet and six inches
her breadth Twenty three feet, two and a half inches
her depth Eight feet and seven inches
and that she measures One hundred Thirty four tons fifty _____ ninety-fifths
that she is a Schooner has no Gallies _____
and _____ head.

And the said Elijah Cobb _____ having
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner _____ has been duly enrolled at
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
