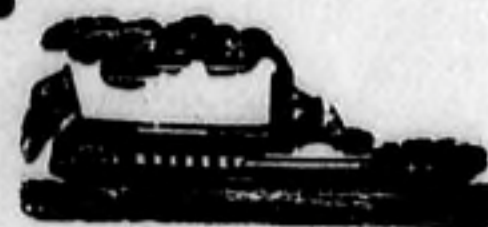

IN CONFORMITY TO

An act of Congress of the United States of America, entitled "an Act for Enrolling and Licensing Ships and Vessels," So. passed the 18th February, 1793, and "an Act to regulate the Foreign and Coasting Trade on the Northern, Northeastern and Northwestern Frontiers of the United States, and for other purposes," passed the 2d March, 1831, and "an Act to provide for the better security of the lives of passengers on board of vessels propelled in whole or in part by steam," passed 7th July, 1838.

Samuel Wilkinson of Buffalo Michigan  
having taken or subscribed the Oath required by the said Acts, and having sworn that he Together  
with B. F. Davison of the same place

CITIZENS OF THE UNITED STATES, sole owners of the Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ or Vessel called the  
Edwin Jenny \_\_\_\_\_ whereof B. F. Davison \_\_\_\_\_  
is at present Master, and, as he hath sworn \_\_\_\_\_ is a

Citizen of the United States, and that the said Ship or Vessel was built at Mount Clemens  
Michigan \_\_\_\_\_ in the year 1837 as appears by Her Enrollment dated  
at this Port the 12th day February now surrendered having  
changed Owner

And The said Enrollment \_\_\_\_\_ having certified that  
the said Schooner or vessel has One Deck \_\_\_\_\_ and Two Masts \_\_\_\_\_ and that her  
length is Twenty feet and Six inches \_\_\_\_\_  
her breadth Sixty One feet and Eleven inches \_\_\_\_\_  
her depth Six feet and Ten inches \_\_\_\_\_  
and that she measures Eighty two \_\_\_\_\_ tons three Seven ninety-fifths.  
that she is a Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has No Gallies \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ head.

And the said Samuel Wilkinson \_\_\_\_\_ having  
agreed to the description and admeasurement above specified, and sufficient security having been given in conform-  
mity with the terms of the said acts, the said Schooner \_\_\_\_\_ has been duly enrolled at  
the Port of Buffalo Creek.
